

ORDINANCE NO. 02-2005

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 0-5-75, "ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CARRYING, POSSESSION, AND/OR TRANSPORTING OF ANY ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR ON ANY PUBLIC PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE CITY OF ATHENS, ILLINOIS, OR ON ANY PUBLIC WAY OR RIGHT-OF-WAY OTHER THAN WHEN IN ORIGINAL PACKAGE AND WITH SEAL UNBROKEN"

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Athens, Menard County, Illinois, has determined to amend Ordinance 0-5-75 regarding the possession and consumption of alcoholic liquor on public property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATHENS, MENARD COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. The aforesaid Ordinance 0-5-75 is hereby amended by deleting the current Section 3 thereof and substituting the following as and for said Section 3:

SECTION 3. Drinking alcoholic liquor on public property belonging to the City of Athens, Illinois. Except as may be strictly permitted by ordinance of the City of Athens, Illinois, no person shall consume any alcoholic liquor on any public property belonging to the City of Athens, Illinois, or on any public way or right-of-way (including but not limited to public highways, streets, alleys, and/or sidewalks) within the corporate limits of the City of Athens, Illinois;

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
